The Fruits of Patience

Food insecurity is a major issue for the people of Haiti; a balanced diet is almost impossible for those in poverty. Fresh fruit would seem like an unattainable treat for many Haitian children, but through ICCM's partnership with The Eden Projects, it has become possible!

ICCM is providing Eden with land to grow these precious trees, through our own schools and the sponsored children's families. Parents sign agreements to participate in planting, protecting, watering, and tending to the trees planted around their homes. In exchange, they agree to allow the trees to be counted, measured, and studied as Eden researches the best varieties of trees for each soil type.

Eden is in the process of planting 80,000 trees on ICCM property (48,000 of which are fruit trees). Mangoes, papayas, citron, and other delicious and nutritious fruits will one day grow on these trees and feed many hungry children. This partnership has many benefits including reversing deforestation, restoring the soil through nitrogen-fixing, as well as providing parents with the opportunity to participate in planting and tending the trees, and eventually can be used for lumber to build furniture.

As we stand alongside our children and their families in Haiti, we realize that food security is a major problem. We love to cooperate with our Creator to restore the planet and multiply food for the hungry children we serve!

Laying the Foundation for an Eggciting Future

Last year a Canadian donor gave towards hens in Brazil, which are a very practical gift in this country. Hens were distributed through the ICCM school in Monte Santo, Bahia, to families who were particularly needy and unable to feed their children on a regular basis. Each family received one hen, and they were extremely happy and grateful for this enormous gift.

Around a year after the original gift, ICCM staff heard from one of the families that their hens have multiplied! Not only has this one hen kept this family fed for the past year, which has allowed the children to focus better in school and grow, but now this gift has rippled out to cause more good.

Second generation hens (and a rooster too) are just one example of how one gift can ripple out and cause so much good for families in Brazil and beyond!

Reminders

Writing Your Child

Sponsorship is so much more than the money—letters mean so much to sponsored children because it shows them how much their sponsors care about them! When they know you care, they try harder in school and make better decisions because they know you have invested in them and want them to succeed. Sending letters is as easy as emailing us at iccm@fmcic.ca or using the online message form on our website!

Sending Gifts to Your Child

Gifts and letters can take up to three months to travel from you to your sponsored child due to the inconsistency of the postage system—especially for children who live in remote rural areas. Due to this, it is important to keep in mind that for your gift to reach your child in time for Christmas, their birthday, or other significant event be sure to send them at least two months in advance so it will be sure to arrive on time!

Your Tax Receipt

With tax season coming up in a few months we want to remind you that some giving, such as monthly sponsorship and special projects, are receiptable while donations to child gifts are non-receiptable under the CRA. If you have any questions about your tax deductible receipt when it arrives, please give the ICCM office a call.
